Orphan Europe Academy courses have already for several years been an excellent opportunity for all those who need specific education in the field of inborn errors of metabolism to gain knowledge about most important related practical issues transferred from a group of experts through lectures, seminars, as well as through problem oriented and free discussions. All previous courses have been evaluated by participants as very useful professional meetings of high quality.

The focus of this course are inborn errors of metabolism in neonatal age. The course is aimed primarily at paediatricians with about 2-3 years of clinical experience in neonatology, but everybody who might benefit from the course programme is welcome.

The venue of the course will be Center for Advanced Academic Studies, which is a dislocated part of the University of Zagreb and one of the favourite educational points in Croatia. For sure, one of the reasons is City of Dubrovnik as a famous tourist destination. The accommodation will be in one of the hotels within a short walking distance. The course is designed for about 35 participants and 15 speakers.
